

ISEAL Code of Good Practice for Setting Social and Environmental Standards

Setting Standards

- > Global normative reference for setting international standards
- > Builds on international trade rules (TBT Annex 3)
- Incorporates unique process requirements of social and environmental standard-setting
- Compliance is an ISEAL membership requirement



Key Considerations

- > Justify the need for a new standard and clearly define its social and environmental objectives (arts. 5.2 and 6.1).
- Multi-stakeholder standard-setting processes that are open, balanced and transparent (arts. 5.1 and 5.6).
- Provide a meaningful voice to those directly affected by the standard and facilitate access of disadvantaged groups (arts. 7.2 and 7.4).
- > Make the standard available free of charge (art. 5.7).



Third Party Certification and Accreditation

Assessing Conformity

Credibility is particularly important for social and environmental claims:

- Non-product related
- > The buyer only has trust in the seller

Compliance with ISO Standards for third party certification and accreditation (ISO 65, 17021 and 17011)

> Ensures a credible guarantee
