- **CASM as a catalyst for development through social, economic and environmental changes in ASM communities around the world through advocacy, networking, knowledge sharing and grass-roots projects**

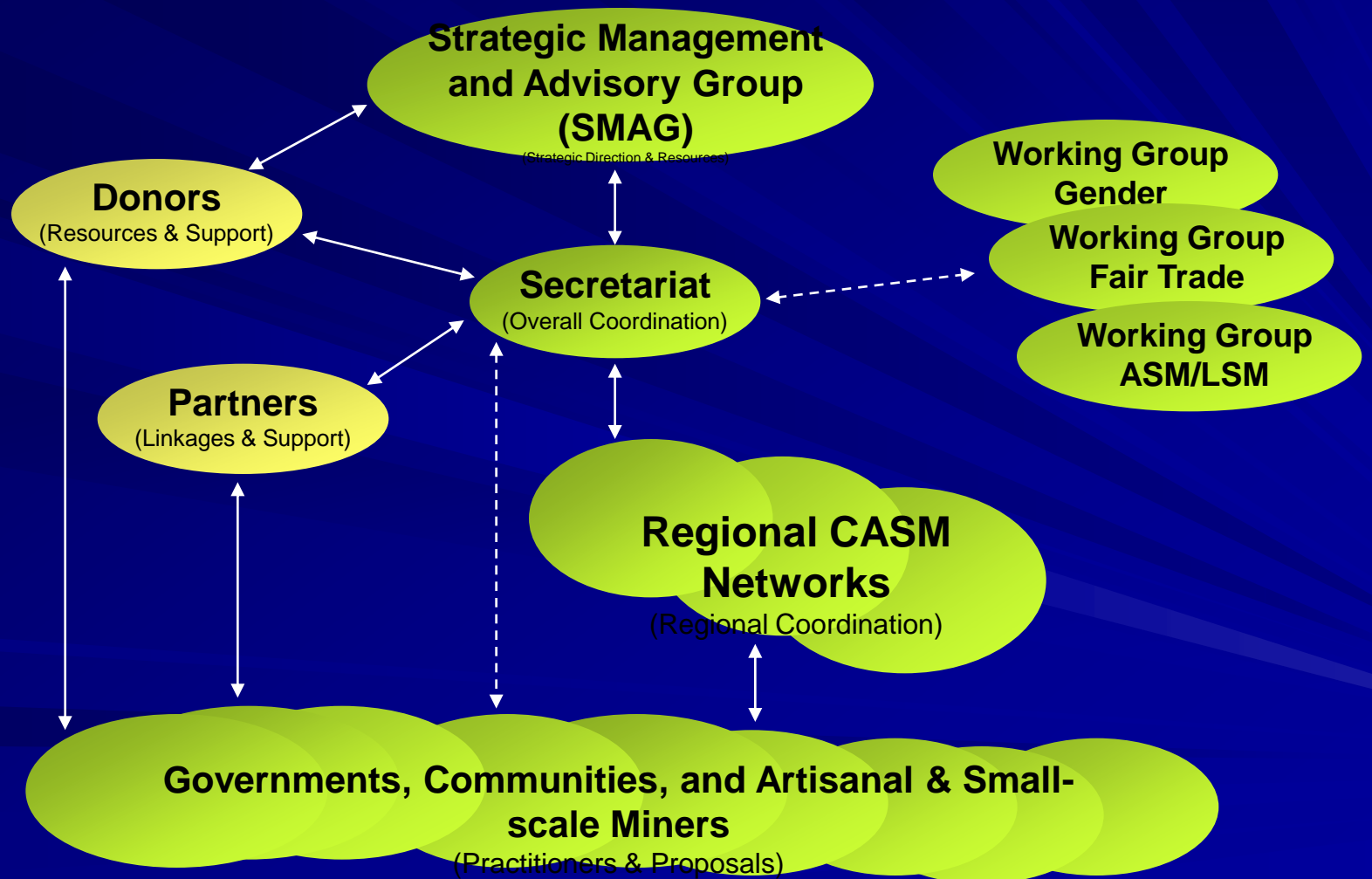
- **CASM main activities:**

CASM - Funding

- Multi-Donor Trust Fund since 2006 : DFID, Denmark, World Bank and others
- Source and Use of Funds FY 2009 (approx):

Source of Funds

Direct funding **800,000 USD**

Use of Funds

Advocacy **60,000 USD**

Knowledge and Partnerships **540,000 USD**

Regional CASMs **0 USD**

Management and Administration **180,000 USD**
