ASM in China



Over 5 million Chinese work in ASM. Mining occurs in every province.







ASM Impacts in China

- Produce a significant portion of the world's mine production, including:
 - Around 15-20% of the world's coal,
 - A large portion of the world's antimony, gold, iron, lead, tin, tungsten and zinc.
- Provides significant local private and government revenue, often in the poorest regions of China.





ASM Impacts in China

- ◆ Sept 8, 2009
- 43 miners killed in coal mine gas explosion
- Cause of accident indicated to be "illegal mining."
- All ASM coal activities suspended in district.

- Sept 8, 2009
- 6 miners and 7
 rescuers killed in
 small-scale gold mine
 electrical fire
- Mine located in district investigated by CASM-China in 2007.





ASM Impacts in China

A health, safety, and environmental challenge:

- ASM is often illegal and damages otherwise viable mineral deposits;
- China's ASM coal mining kills ~10,000 miners per year;
- Thousands more ASM miners die of silicosis, accidents and other work related causes;
- Unrestricted excavation and use of chemical reagents, including as cyanide and mercury, have had significant impacts on local environments.







CASM-China Regional Network

- Founded by Shen Lei, AJ Gunson and Phillip Andrew-Speed, with the assistance of a \$15,000 small grant from CASM.
- Inaugural Meeting held in Beijing, January 2004
- CASM-China formalized under the China Mining Association.







CASM-China Activities

- Drafted ASM section for the ongoing effort to reform the 1986/1996 Mineral Resource Law.
- Completing several policy papers on ASM for Ministry of Land and Mineral Resources

CASM-China Regional Network

The Communities and Smg6-Scale Wining Regional Network in China (CASM-China) held its inaugural meeting in Beging from January 5-7, 2004.
