- To focus on solutions

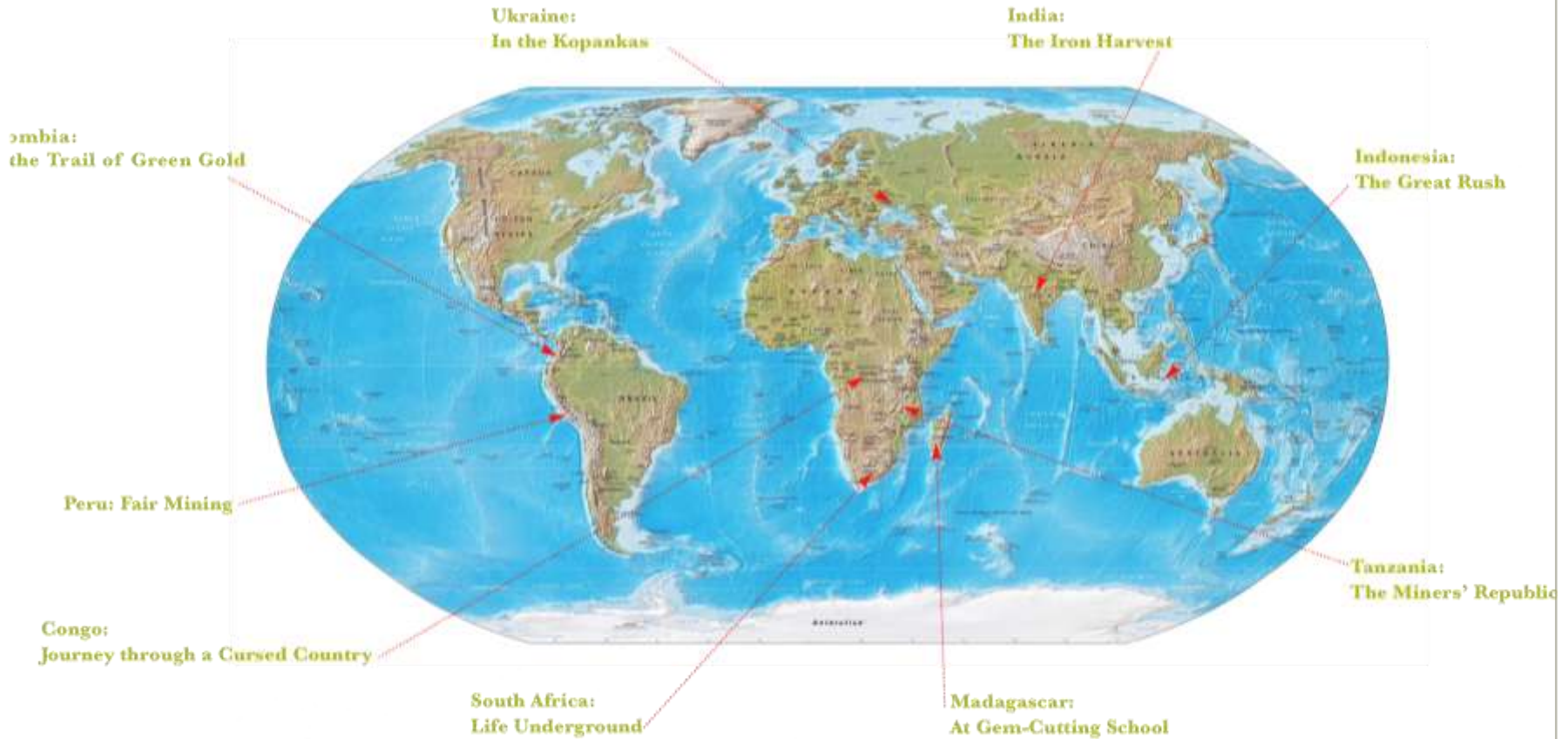
The reports : 8 countries for 3 chapters
